



**Deutsches Museum (Museumsinsel)
8:30 a.m. from the lobby, S-Bahn**

We will take the S-Bahn from the hotel to the museum island, where the German Museum is located. Each participant will receive a day ticket for public transportation. Germany's most famous museum shows us technology in all its facets. A guided tour (English/German) will give us a good insight.

**Walk to Marienplatz
11:30 a.m. Meeting point: Exit of the Deutsches
Museum**

We will reach Marienplatz in 15 minutes on foot.



**We cycle through Munich
12:00 p.m. Marienplatz**

There are **two** options to choose from:

- Leisurely city tour by bicycle. Lunch in the beer garden of the English Garden. Guided tour in two groups (English/German)
- City tour with a tour guide (English) and lunch in the old town.
- In case of very bad weather, we will all walk.

Return to Marienplatz at around 3:30 p.m., followed by free time for shopping and strolling around.

Free time 3:30 p.m.

We suggest using the free time to explore the shops around Marienplatz. For those who want to experience more culture, we recommend visiting the “Residenz,” the official seat of the Bavarian dukes and kings since 1385. There, you can take a good tour with an audio guide.



Meeting point for the gala dinner 6:30 p.m. Meeting point: hotel lobby

We will take tram line 19 or 21 four stops to Opernplatz/Nationaltheater (approx. 10 minutes).

Gala dinner at the Spatenhaus at the opera house - 7:00 p.m.

We invite to the gala dinner already today so that we can relax and celebrate without having to think about the return flight. The Spatenhaus offers delicious food on the 1st floor in the Opernstube with an atmospheric view of the opera house.

Everyone can take the tram back to the hotel individually. Those who wish can also walk.



Saturday, May 9, 2026

BMW World

9:15 a.m. from the lobby

Today we are taking a coach trip to the outskirts of Munich. We would like to start at BMW World, a state-of-the-art complex for customers picking up their new vehicles. It is located in the immediate vicinity of the BMW headquarters and the Olympic Park.

Olympic Tour

11:00 a.m.

The architecture of the 1972 Olympic tent roof is still fascinating. We are given a “Waldi” tour, named after the mascot from back then (English/German). Short walk from BMW World

12:45 p.m.

Our bus takes us to the Allianz Arena in about 20 minutes.

Allianz Arena (FC Bayern München)

1:15 p.m.

The Olympic Stadium was replaced 20 years ago by a new stadium for Germany's most successful soccer club. We will start with a small snack in the visitor arena.

After the tour (English/German), there will be a goal wall shooting competition!



Return to the hotel at 4:00 p.m.

Members are kindly requested to meet at 6:00 p.m. (Meeting will be in the Augustiner-Keller)



Closing dinner in the beer garden at 7:00 p.m. (meeting point: lobby)

Since Augustiner Bräu is said to be the best beer in Munich, we have decided to go to the Augustiner-Keller restaurant. If the weather is good, we have reserved tables in the large beer garden; otherwise, we will go to the "Keller." It is about a 10-minute walk from the hotel (please do not confuse it with the Augustiner Stammhaus/original building).



