City Tour - The Media Harbour Düsseldorf 4:30 PM from the Lobby

We take a walk to the new Düsseldorf. Past the modern K21 Museum and the state parliament of North Rhine-Westphalia, we walk into the converted harbour, where media is 'made' today. We pass the three-part, organically shaped building ensemble 'Neuer Zollhof' by architect Frank O. Gehry. In the Media Harbour we are professionally briefed by city guides. The city tour ends at the foot of the Rhine Tower.

Classic Remise Düsseldorf 9:30 AM Departure from the Lobby

Guided Tour of the Kunstpalast 12:00 PM

In this ensemble of architecture and art, we experience a tour through the history of art to the present day.



Kaiserswerth - Kaiserpfalz 2:00 PM

A ruined imperial palace stands directly on the Rhine in the Kaiserswerth district. In the Middle Ages, the emperor had no fixed residence, but moved from palace to palace. Right next to the ruins, we stop off at the Galerie Burghof brewery located directly on the Rhine.

Side Trip to Wuppertal

The world-famous artist Tony Cragg, the son of an aeronautical engineer, has built his own garden in Wuppertal to exhibit his sculptures. He has lived in Wuppertal for many decades. The bus takes about 45 minutes to the Wuppertal Sculpture Park. There we will be given an explanatory guided tour.

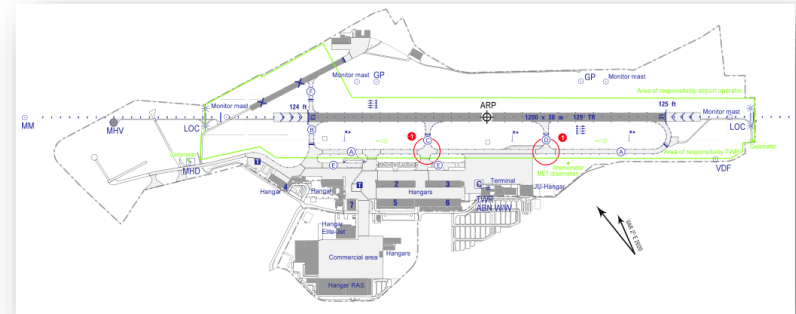

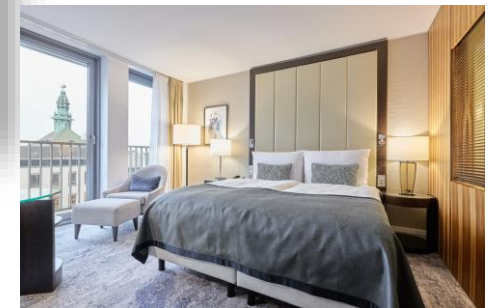
