The hotel is located in the old town about 100m from the market square www.wyndhamwroclawot.com




Meeting at the Bar from 4:30 PM

Short city tour through the old town 5:30 PM from the Lobby


We take our first walk through the old town with an English and German guide.

Saturday, September 13, 2025 - Great history and a look into the future

City tour with small electric buses 9:30 AM from the Lobby

An interesting tour will bring us closer to the old and new Wroclaw. The tour ends at the Centennial Hall.

Centennial Hall 11:30 AM

The hall, built in 1911, has been a UNESCO World Heritage Site since 2006. We are given a guided tour in German and English about the building and its use in different eras.



Within walking distance, we stop off at a small restaurant at the zoo and eat pierogi.

In the afternoon, we offer **two** options to choose from:

- •The newly built Hydropolis Water Knowledge Center
- •Exhibition 1,000 years of the city's history in the Royal Palace











Option 1: Hydropolis 03:30 PM

A modern museum has been built from a 19th century underground reservoir, which interactively explains important topics relating to water as a raw material.

Option 2: Royal Palace 03:30 PM

This museum presents 1,000 years of the city's history under the constant change of rulers.


